

**Rules, Responsibilities, and Conduct Requirements for the Patty Ice Arena**

### Scheduled Rental Time Cancellations

Cancellation of scheduled ice times must be completed in writing at least 10 days in advance of the scheduled ice time being cancelled.

### Hospitality Rooms

Hospitality rooms will not compete with the facility concession stand. It is the responsibility of the user to ensure that Hospitality rooms will only be used by authorized individuals (coaches, volunteers, referee's, etc.). The Hospitality room, must be maintained in an orderly fashion that permits use of the room by facility staff during daily facility operations.

### Other

- No one is allowed on the ice surface during Zamboni resurfacing. Prior to the Zamboni coming on to the ice surface, all users must exit the ice surface.
- All players, participants, officials, spectators, and members of the public in attendance at any event assume full and exclusive responsibility for their own safety.
- At all times, non-adult participants must be actively supervised by an adult, such as a coach, teacher, or parent.
- It is the responsibility of each user, team, and organization to leave the facilities in an acceptable condition. This includes, but is not limited to, trash, clothing, and gear.
- Vandalism or misuse of any part of the Patty Ice Arena may result in an individual, team,

- Balls or any other items shall not be batted, thrown, hit, or kicked against or at walls, doors, windows, lights.
- Pounding on the Plexiglas is strictly prohibited and will result in expulsion from the facility.
- No puck shooting shall occur while staff is on the ice or when the Zamboni gate is open.
- Other than water contained in a shatter proof container, food and beverages are prohibited on the ice surface.
- Approval from the Ice Arena staff must be obtained prior to posting signs, flyers, banners, or other advertisement or similar items. Banners and signs may be placed on the glass around the rink. If they are taped to the glass all tape must be removed from the glass. It is preferred that Banners are hung from the glass with hooks.
- Anyone actively participating in hockey or broomball activities MUST wear a helmet. It is strongly recommended that full equipment be worn.
- All players and coaches must abide by USA Hockey Rules and Regulations.
- All players 18 years and under must wear full equipment, unless acting as an instructor.
- Helmets are recommended for all public skaters.
- The Ice Arena staff may refuse admittance to the facility or instruct individuals to leave the facility for violation of rules or other dangerous or disruptive behavior.
- Group users shall ensure that each team cleans their assigned team room after each use.
- Rules and policies are subject to change or be added to due to normal updates, unusual circumstances, or any other reason the Patty Ice Arena Manager deems fit in order to provide facilities and programs that best fit the needs of UAF and the Fairbanks community.
